Like Physical remodeling where one identifies areas that need improved and then tears them out and replaces them with something better, spiritual remodeling is the process where one identifies areas that are causing unhappiness and chaos, and then tears them out and replaces them with things that enable greater joy and peace in Jesus Christ.

● True Discipleship

The original twelve disciples memorize the Master's words, wrote them down to share later, and tried to become as much like Jesus as possible—a mirror image of Him. They are then commissioned to go and make disciples—teaching them everything they have learned from the Master. Mathew 28:19-20, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Teaching them to observe all that I commanded you."

● Mothers of Millennials

Helping mothers learn how to pray for their prodigal millennials. The current spiritual stronghold in our society is powerful—pulling our kids away from God, the church, and biblical truths. This talk helps women understand how to apply the teaching of Jesus Christ to these heart wrenching family scenarios in order to release the full restoration power of God into these difficult situations.

Most women are remodelers at heart—so the concepts of spiritual remodeling resonate well when presented and discussed in women's Bible study groups, conferences, and seminars. Mary sprinkles her talks with analogies to hammer and tape measures, a healthy dose of humor, and gut honest truth. Life is tough, Mary understands this and connects with the rawness so many women experience, and shows them how she fought back by surrendering every area of her life to Jesus Christ.

Mary is a born-again follower of Christ and has been for many years, but it wasn't until her life faced imminent collapse that she started spiritually growing. Facing a crumbling marriage and rebellious children, she heard the Father say, "You can trust Jesus—be like Him." She rose to the challenge and as a result every area of her life has undergone a spiritual remodel. That remodel saved her marriage, helped her reconnect with her precious children, and enabled her to experience a whole new level of joy and peace in her relationship with Jesus Christ. She considers it God's call on her life to help other women do the same.

After college, Mary joined a silo construction crew. The job ultimately took her to Pennsylvania where she met Tony. They would later marry and eventually launch their own construction business.

After several years, the couple found themselves on the construction site of a very challenging job with a very difficult and seemingly hopeless marriage. After a lunch-break argument, Tony heard God's still small voice whisper, "Build your marriage like you are building this home, and it will not fail." It would become the turning point of their marriage and their careers. Under the direction of the Master Carpenter, Mary and Tony began to rebuild their dilapidated relationship and their lives as authentic disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ.

In 2012, the pair removed their tool belts, professionally speaking, and launched Carpenter's Guide Ministries, a non-profit dedicated to rebuilding the lives of others.
